URBAN INFRASTRUCTURE - PROJECT DELIVERY



Barangaroo Delivery Authority

Siecap assisted the NSW Government agency, the Barangaroo Delivery Authority in the transformation from a disused container terminal on the edge of Sydney's CBD into a spectacular 22-hectare waterfront precinct. Siecap's role included managing all remediation works activities, associated contracts and budgets, as well as all levels of stakeholder engagement, including government agency, local community and other commercial stakeholders.

MINE TAILING DAM MIGRATION - PROJECT MANAGEMENT



Siecap was engaged by BHP to undertake a major planning and transformation strategy to enable the migration away from storing wet tailings in dams to dry storage across a portfolio of eight [8] operating coal mines in Queensland and NSW. Works included a strategic scenario planning and feasibility study for a major capital programme (>\$1b) over the medium to long term, encompassing multiple options around storage capacities, mine planning, geotechnical issues, approvals and investments, aggregated to portfolio level, and prioritised against capital, time and risk reduction profiles. Solutions identified integrated options to maintain business continuity and manage risk while aligning with BHP investment processes and governance requirements.

PROJECT PRIORITISATION - GOVERNMENT PROJECT



Siecap was engaged by Building Queensland (BO). The Queensland Governments Major Project to develop a best practice project prioritisation framework that addresses both the required rigour, flexibility and local context; to provide objective and transparent advice to the Queensland Government that will ultimately enable better infrastructure decisions. This included a review of alternate global prioritisation frameworks to determine how other jurisdictions prioritise projects and their relating relevance and application for BQ's requirements.

URBAN INFRASTRUCTURE - PROJECT ASSURANCE



Siecap was engaged by the Queensland Department of State Development Special Projects Unit (SPU) to provide expert advice regarding the adequacy of existing program management arrangements. The purpose of the engagement was to review the current state processes and to propose a fit for purpose program management model to meet the evolving needs of the SPU. This included understanding the current full scope of SPU project management practices and the development and documentation of a fit for purpose program management approach for the DSD SPU.

MINING INFRASTRUCTURE - INDEPENDENT ASSURANCE



Siecap were engaged by BHP to assist in an Independent Assurance review of a major shaft rehabilitation project. The scope of the engagement was addressed in two sections: Execution Readiness and Capital Estimate and Project Schedule. The Siecap team worked closely with the owner's team to complete the assurance review that comprised of a detailed assessment of the project capital cost estimates, and schedule. These elements were all tested, as well as the overall interfaces between execution strategy, cost and schedule.

RAIL INFRASTRUCTURE



Over an 18-month period Siecap supported Transport for New South Wales in the overall program delivery and management of the Newcastle light Rail urban renewal project.
